Members of the choir are drawn from a rich variety of organisations and reflect a broad spectrum of Cape Town.

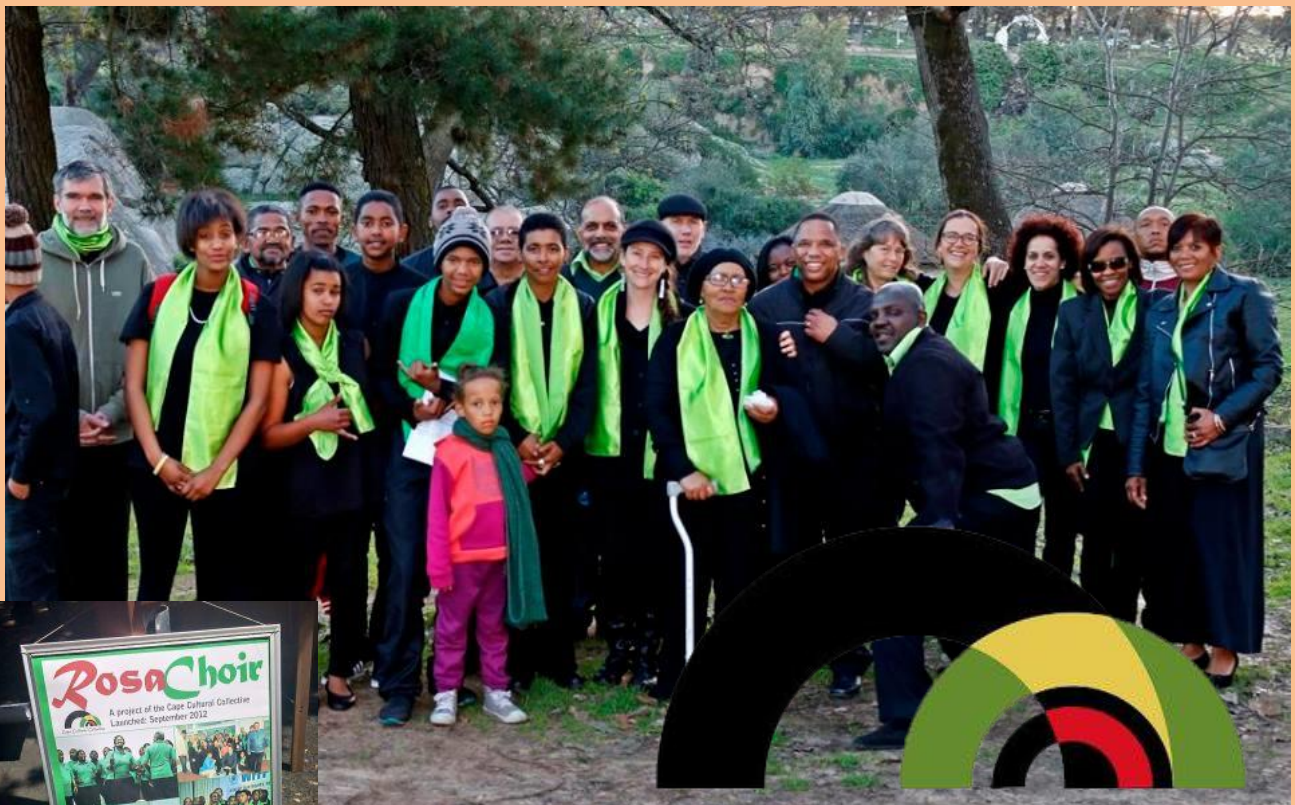
The amazing choir will not only perform songs from their repertoire but will also share their experiences of being part of such a diverse and inclusive project.
